Enrolment

Enrolling is free and voluntary. If you choose not to enrol you can still receive health care services from your chosen GP, general practice or primary health care services provider.

Advantages of enrolling are that your visits to the doctor will be cheaper and you will have direct access to a range of services linked to the PHO.

Appointments

Please ring **(09) 281 0332** to book an appointment. You can also do this online via our patient portal - ManageMyHealth (accessible from www.shortlandhealth.co.nz).

Every effort will be made to accommodate your preferred time. However, emergencies will always be given priority. Our reception staff will attempt to contact you if there are any unforeseen delays or if your GP has been called away.

Extend consultations are available.

Payments

Fees are payable at the time of consultation.

We accept cash, eftpos, cheque, visa, mastercard and online payments. Paywave is also available.

Fees for enrolled and registered patients are subsidised by the Government for various age groups and services costs are listed at the practice. If you have any queries, please contact reception. They are always happy to help.

Repeat Prescriptions

We are happy to issue repeat prescriptions. However, we ask that you give us as much advance notice as possible - 48 hours' warning being the minimum.

Repeat prescriptions do incur a charge (\$28) and the doctor may need to see you prior to issuing for clinical and/or legal reasons - especially if you are not seeing your regular GP.
